- In the **Trip Pool**, tap **Filter** to select filters so that you see only the kinds of trips you are interested in
 - In the PERIOD / LENGTH section, select Start and End dates, and/ or the Minimum or Maximum number of days
 - In the BASE / LAYOVER section, enter a Base and/ or Layover; You can filter for co-terminals; Separate multiple cities with a comma
 - In the OTHER section:
 - Enter your Role; If you enter more than one, separate them with a comma and no spaces (for example, FA,FB,FC)
 - Select whether you want only premium pay trips, or only morning or afternoon flights

After you set your filters:

- To update the Trip Pool, tap Apply
- To remove any filters you may have set and once again view all the available trips, tap **Clear**
- To save your selections, tap **Save** (see other side for more information)



Saving a Trip Pool Filter

If the filters you selected are ones you will be using repeatedly, tap **Save**. The **Save Filter** window opens

- Enter a descriptive FILTER NAME
- Select Subscription (max 5) to receive a message when a trip that matches your filter becomes available
 - Select Quiet to stop receiving messages relating to this filter
- Select Default to set this filter as your default. If you do so, each time you open the Trip Pool only those trips that meet the filter criteria will display
- To save your changes, tap **Save**

The blue **Filter** heading indicates that a filter is being applied to your view
